### REMEDICATION WILL CORRECT HISTORICAL CONTAMINATION AT BARANGAROO AT NO COST TO THE PUBLIC

**4 July 2010**

“The long standing contamination of a small part of the Barangaroo site will be rectified at no cost to the public”, said CEO John Tabart.

“As was first reported in July 2009, the Barangaroo Delivery Authority will pursue those liable for the contamination once the remediation process is completed. *(BDA media release 24 July 2009 available [www.barangaroo.com](http://www.barangaroo.com) )*

“Should any contamination be the result of activity by the state, then those costs will be borne out of developer payments by Lend Lease.

“Should other parties be found liable for contamination, the Authority will pursue payment by those parties through negotiation, mediation and if necessary, legal action.

“No cost will be borne by the taxpayer for any remediation works undertaken to address what is a longstanding problem.

“This reflects the fact that the \$6 billion transformation of Barangaroo will be delivered without cost to the public, including 50% public open space, two new harbour coves and an iconic natural headland park”, said Mr. Tabart.
