Dear Neighbour,

Thank you for your continued support for the fabulous events we host at Barangaroo.

This letter is to inform you that **NYE2023 at Barangaroo** activities will be taking place throughout Barangaroo Reserve between **Wednesday 27 December 2023 – Tuesday 2 January 2024.**

Barangaroo Reserve is one of Sydney's best vantage points to ring in the New Year and is the ideal spot for families, friends and couples to enjoy panoramic views of the fireworks and western face of the Sydney Harbour Bridge.

The NSW Government has a commitment to ensure that all NSW Government managed public vantage points will be free for the general public to enjoy, and we're delighted that this year Barangaroo Reserve will provide a free and non-ticketed site for all to enjoy. The event area will be limited to a maximum capacity of 10,500, including 250 in our dedicated Accessible Viewing Area. Plans have been made to ensure that the crowds are managed with respect to the local residences community.

Barangaroo Reserve will be closed to the general public earlier than usual to accommodate the safety and security of the event operations. The Reserve will close from Midnight 30 December 2023 and reopen at 6am on Monday 1 January 2024 (or when it's safe to do so). Access to the event will be via Wulugul Walk and into the Cutaway. All other access points to Barangaroo Reserve will be closed. Clear signage at these points will redirect patrons to the entry point.

Event hours

- Sunday 31 December 2023 | 12.00pm 0.45am (Monday 1 January 2024)
- Queuing will commence in the Cutaway from 7.00am
- Gates to the Reserve will open from 12noon
- 9pm Calling Country fireworks (8 min)
- Midnight Fireworks (12 min)

Key messages:

- Visitors are being asked to prepare and plan ahead of time.
- Event will operate on a first come first serve basis. Once the site is full, it will be closed and no pass outs available.
- Visitors are being asked to arrive early, and arrive together, to avoid disappointment.
- All visitors must be aware of Prohibited Items and agree to Terms and Conditions of entry, including bag checks.
- You can bring your own picnic or there will also be a selection of food trucks onsite with a wide range
 of delicious cuisines to enjoy.
- BYO alcohol is not permitted however there will be a bar offering a selection of wine, beer, spirits and non-alcoholic beverages for purchase.
- Pedestrian diversions in place the way you travel in will be different to how you get home.
- Keep our Precinct sparkling and leave nothing to waste.





Additional overlay for crowd management

Due to the larger crowds expected we have installed additional variable messaging boards (VMS boards) and PA system strategically placed around the perimeter of Barangaroo to disperse important key and safety messaging as required. We will also have customer service wayfinders assisting patrons with directions.

Work hours (set up and pack down)

- Site set up works will take place:
 - o Wednesday 27 Saturday 30 December 2023 | 7.00am 7.00pm
 - o Sunday 31 December 2023 | 7.00am 11.00am
- Pack down activities will take place:
 - o Monday 1 January 2024 | 0.45am 6.00am | light bump out & cleaning
 - o Monday 1 January and Tuesday 2 January 2024 | 7.00am 7.00pm

What you can expect

- Light noise from site set up works. All work zones will be managed by experienced site staff.
- Audio system playing ambient music throughout the day. Noise will be kept to low levels.
- Noise from PA announcements managing crowd movements during the event hours.
- Towns Place and Merriman Street will be used for unloading/loading during event set up and pack down. All vehicle movements through access points and in the Reserve will be managed by licensed traffic controllers.
- Local road closures will be in place on Sunday 31 December 2023.
